- Exemplifies the spirit of JCCASAC in advocating for and meeting the needs of all students.
- Skillful and dedicated classroom teacher who is planning to continue in an active teaching status.

### Nomination Packet Must Include:

- ☐ Nomination Form
  - ☐ Letter of recommendation from an administrator *(not to exceed 1 page)*
  - ☐ Letter of recommendation from a student *(not to exceed 1 page)*
  - ☐ Letter of recommendation from peer/outside agency *(not to exceed 1 page)*
  - ☐ Resume
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- The JCCASAC Board reviews all applications and selects the Teacher of the Year at the March Board Meeting
  - The Teacher of the Year will be notified in April
  - The JCCASAC Teacher of the Year will be recognized at the JCCASAC Annual Conference (conference fees to be paid by the sponsoring county office)
  - The JCCASAC Board is unable to consider incomplete nomination packets.
